



Gidget Foundation Australia Program Clinician Role Description

FTE:

This position will be for 4 days per week.

Contract:

This role will initially be contracted for a 1 year period, with the option for annual extensions thereafter, as required and feasible.

Remuneration:

The annual gross salary will be \$123,200 plus superannuation for 4 days per week (equivalent to a full-time salary of \$140,000 plus superannuation).

Primary Responsibilities:

The Gidget Foundation Australia (GFA) Program Clinician will primarily be responsible for managing and implementing the organisation's triage / prescreening process for potential new clients, as well as coordinating the Gidget Village Group Treatment Program. This role will report to the GFA Clinical Development Manager.

New Client Triage and Pre-Screening

1. Develop the clinical procedures to enable a client triage / pre-screening process to be implemented for all potential new GFA clients.
2. Review and provide feedback into the administrative procedures for the implementation of a client triage / pre-screening process for new GFA clients.
3. Implement and manage the approved client triage / pre-screening process for all potential new clients.

Gidget Village Group Treatment Program


1. Oversee, and provide clinical advice, regarding the implementation and expansion of the current Gidget Village group treatment program, including identifying/recruiting facilitators, recruiting appropriate participants and ensuring consistency and quality of program content.
2. Identify opportunities to diversify the types of groups delivered through the program, e.g. grief & loss, dads etc. and coordinate their implementation.
3. Identify opportunities to diversify the locations of group implementation e.g. at Gidget House extensions where appropriate.
4. Investigate the feasibility of delivering a pilot group via telehealth.

Clinical Support of GFA Staff

1. Provide ad hoc clinical support to GFA administrative staff, as required, in relation to questions around client eligibility etc.
2. Review all clinical collateral and copy (including digital aspects such as the website) prior to publication.
3. Debrief GFA organisational staff, in particular reception staff, as the need arises based on eventualities within their day to day work.
4. Establish and oversee the implementation of the organisation's Employee Assistance Program.

Peer Support and Clinician Training

1. In consultation with the GFA Clinician Educator, provide informal clinical peer support, as required, for GFA clinicians to support their care of clients with more complex needs or situations.
2. Work with the Gidget Clinician Educator to offer mentoring and support to appropriate clinicians wishing to upskill in the perinatal mental health field.
1. Assist the Gidget Clinician Educator to design and implement the annual training workshop for all GFA clinicians.



Spokesperson for Gidget Foundation Australia

1. Act as a clinical speaker on behalf of Gidget Foundation Australia both internally and externally, as appropriate and feasible, including at the EWP midwives' training workshop.
2. Interview prospective GFA clinicians, with the Gidget House Program Manager and/or GFA Program Manager.
3. Advise and review clinical content for all GFA collateral, including the GFA website.

Experience Required:

For this role, the Foundation will be looking to recruit a clinical psychologist, registered psychologist or accredited mental health social worker with significant experience working in a clinical capacity within perinatal mental health.
